III. Nature of Practice:

This collaborative agreement is to establish and maintain a practice model in which the nurse practitioner will provide health care services under the general supervision of Eric Salata, M.D. This practice shall encompass medical aesthetics, family practice and shall focus on aesthetics, health screening and supervision, wellness and health education and counseling, and the treatment of common health problems and aesthetic needs.

IV. Description of the duties and management areas for which the ARNP is responsible:

A. Duties of the ARNP:

The ARNP may interview clients, obtain and record health histories, perform physical and development assessments, order appropriate diagnostic tests, diagnose health problems, manage the health care of those clients for which she has been educated, provide health teaching and counseling, initiate referrals, and maintain health records.

B. The conditions for which the ARNP may initiate treatment include, but are not limited to:

Services offered may include dermatological procedures, minor cosmetic procedures, Botox and other filler procedures, laser hair removal or other laser treatments, hormone replacement therapy, anti-aging services, hair loss treatments, weight loss, diet and nutritional counseling, lifestyle change, and other health and wellness services. Acne (medication and topical treatments), anti-aging, diabetes, nutrition, general health and wellness, medical weight loss, skin care products, neutraceuticals, injectable neurotoxins, injectable dermal fillers, sclerotherapy, Platelet rich plasma injections (PRP), chemical peels, iLipo, Endymed, Ulthera, laser treatments, CoolSculpting, and other aesthetic treatments.

C. Treatments that may be initiated by the ARNP, depending on the patient condition and judgment of the ARNP:



Services offered may include dermatological procedures, minor cosmetic procedures, including but not limited to laser hair removal or other laser treatments, hormone replacement therapy, anti-aging services, hair loss treatments, weight loss, diet and nutritional counseling and prescribing, lifestyle change, and other health and wellness services. Acne (medication and topical treatments), anti-aging, diabetes, nutrition, general health and wellness, medical weight loss, skin care products, neutraceuticals, injectable neurotoxins, injectable dermal fillers, sclerotherapy, Platelet rich plasma injections (PRP), chemical peels, iLipo, Endymed, radio frequency, laser treatments, microneedling, ThermiVam ThermSmooth Face, Thermi Tight, CoolSculpting, and other aesthetic treatments.

May also include some urgent care services. Also includes supervision of aesthetician Iliad's Rodriguez and any other employees.

D. Drug therapies that the ARNP may prescribe, initiate, monitor, alter, or order:

(ARNPs CANNOT PRESCRIBE CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES)

Any prescription medication which is not listed as a controlled substance and which is within the scope of training and knowledge base of the nurse practitioner. Includes specially compounded topical anesthetics.

V. Duties of the Physician:

The physician shall provide general supervision for routine health care and management of common health problems, aesthetic treatments, and provide consultation and/or accept referrals for complex health problems. The physician shall be available by telephone or by other communication device when not physically available on the premises.

VI. Specific Conditions and Requirements for Direct Evaluation

Any condition requiring direct physician evaluation will be referred out immediately.

VII. All parties to this agreement share equally in the responsibility for reviewing treatment protocols as needed and no less than annually.



The supervising physician is responsible for submitting a notice to the Board of Medicine that they have entered into a supervisory relationship with an ARNP.
